from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy)**

Boromarajonani College of Nursing, Chon Buri, Faculty of Nursing, Prabaromarajchanok Institute, is an educational institution that adheres to the principles of good governance. Our duty is to produce nursing personnel who possess academic and professional knowledge and skills, and are equipped with moral, ethical integrity, and international competencies. Moreover, we are committed to developing nursing knowledge, providing academic services to public health personnel, and serving the communities. In addition, we aim to preserve, develop, and enhance the identity of institute's beautiful arts and culture.

To strengthen the culture and values of honesty in working with morality and ethics without conflicts of interest from performing duties and prevent corruption, we have established a policy of not accept gifts or presents related to the performance of our duties as follows:

1. Staff of Boromarajonani College of Nursing, Chonburi, at all levels, must refrain from receiving presents and gifts of any kind in the performance of their duties, whether directly or indirectly.
2. Staff of Boromarajonani College of Nursing, Chonburi, at all levels, must not seek to obtain presents, gifts, or any other unlawful benefits.
3. In offering congratulations, good wishes, and expressing welcome or condolences on various occasions, expression methods such as signing greeting cards, greeting books, or using online media should be employed traditionally instead of giving tangible gifts.
